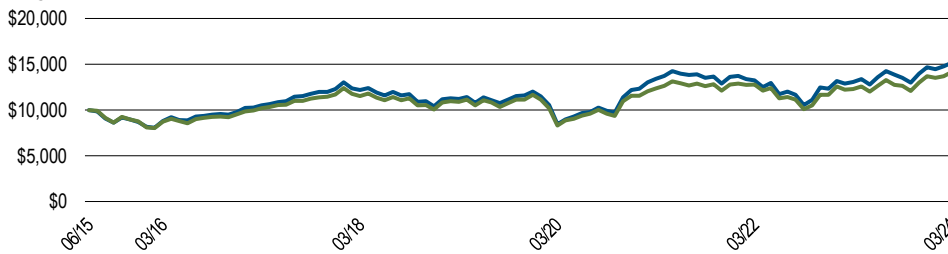


PIMCO RAE Global ex-US Fund

Time-tested systematic approach to global ex U.S. value investing

By aiming to capture robust sources of excess returns and capitalizing on market inefficiencies, this strategy takes an innovative value approach to global equities. It is designed to outperform the MSCI All Country World ex US Value Index.

Price-to-book is a ratio used to compare a stocks market value to its book value. It is calculated by dividing the current closing price of the stock by the latest quarters book value per share. The **Sharpe Ratio** measures the risk-adjusted performance. The risk-free rate is subtracted from the rate of return for a portfolio and the result is divided by the standard deviation of the risk-free rate subtracted from the portfolio returns. **P/E Ratio** is a ratio of security price to earnings per share. Typically, an undervalued security is characterized by a low P/E ratio, while an overvalued security is characterized by a high P/E ratio. Trailing P/E Ratio looks back at 12-month earnings per share while Forward P/E Ratio looks at earnings per share estimates for the next fiscal year. **Price-to-sales** is a valuation ratio that compares a company's stock price to its revenues. The price-to-sales ratio is an indicator of the value placed on each dollar of a company's sales or revenues. Weighted Average Market Capitalization refers to a stock market index in which larger companies (i.e. with higher market capitalization) have more influence on the index performance. **Volatility** is measured by the standard deviation, or dispersion of a set of data from its mean, based on historical portfolio returns. A larger spread of data indicates higher standard deviation and higher volatility.

The MSCI All Country World ex US Value Index captures large and mid-cap securities exhibiting overall value style characteristics across a group of developed and emerging markets countries. The value investment style characteristics for index construction of the MSCI All Country World ex US Value Index are defined using three variables: book value to price, 12-month forward earnings to price and dividend yield. It is not possible to invest directly in an unmanaged index. The MSCI All Country World ex US Index is a free float-adjusted market capitalization weighted index that is designed to measure the equity market performance of developed and emerging markets.
